### After an Unexpected Power Loss, the RAID Adapter Might Hang

When power to a SuperCap-protected RAID adapter is interrupted unexpectedly, cache offload begins.

During internal validation, Broadcom observed that the MegaRAID<sup>®</sup> SAS 9361-16i controllers might occasionally hang before the cache is restored after a successful cache offload. However, the cached data remains in the flash, and, on subsequent cold boot, the cache is restored properly.

This issue is noted only on MegaRAID SAS 9361-16i controllers.

### Identifying the MegaRAID Firmware and CPLD Versions Using StorCLI

The Storage Command Line Interface (StorCLI) is a software designed for the MegaRAID product line. To identify if your firmware requires a Complex Programmable Logical Device (CPLD) update, run the `storcli /cx show all` command to display the CPLD versions.

- If your firmware displays **CPLD Version = 04468-031**, your controller firmware is updated with the latest CPLD code and you do not need to update the firmware.

The following StorCLI code snippet (output truncated) is an example of a 9361-16i controller and its CPLD version.

- If your firmware displays **CPLD Version = 04468-021**, your firmware is not updated with the latest available CPLD code, and it requires an update.

The following StorCLI code snippet (output truncated) is an example of an affected 9361-16i controller and its CPLD version.

## Updating MegaRAID Firmware and CPLD Versions Using StorCLI

To update the firmware, use StorCLI version *1.18.xx* or later, and perform the following steps:

- List the RAID controllers in your system to ensure that you have the correct controller number for MegaRAID SAS 9361-16i by running the `storcli show` command.
- Ensure that MegaRAID SAS 9361-16i controller is running on the MegaRAID 6.13 firmware package `<24.19.0-0047>` or later by running the `storcli /cx show` command.
  - If you are not running the MegaRAID 6.13 firmware, you need to first upgrade your firmware. Run the `storcli /cx download file=<firmware package>` command.
  - Perform one of the following actions:
    - If the Online Controller Reset (OCR) feature is turned to ON in your system, restart your controller by running the `storcli /cx restart` command.
    - If the Online Controller Reset (OCR) feature is not turned to ON in your system, you need to reboot the system.
  - After the OCR or reboot is successful, verify that the new firmware has been updated by running the `storcli /cx show all` command.
- If your MegaRAID SAS 9361-16i controller is running on the MR 6.13 firmware package and if this firmware package requires a CPLD update, see [Table 1, CPLD Version Comparison](#), and use the applicable `CPLD.rom` file and update the firmware by running the `storcli /cx download file=<CPLD filename.rom>` command.
- Perform a clean reboot of the system.
- Ensure that the new CPLD code has been updated by running the `storcli /cx show all` command.

### Obtaining The Updated CPLD Package

The Complex Programmable Logic Device (CPLD) is programmed specifically for the 9361-16i. The updated CPLD package is factory-programmed and is available at <https://www.broadcom.com/support/download-search> for download.

- Any subsequent revisions will include the CPLD fix.
- Versions of the 9361-16i boards are already in the field. The sticker on the controller shows the Level 3 number. If the Level 3 number is *03-25708-27 Rev004*, the board might require an update to the CPLD.
- Broadcom recommends updating the CPLD on the next scheduled maintenance cycle.
- The updated CPLD file along with update instructions are provided with the MegaRAID 6.13 and later packages.
- You can also contact Broadcom support to obtain the updated CPLD package.
